

What is a Christian Experience Weekend?

A CEW is a renewal weekend for adults. It is a time away from the busyness of life to focus on your relationship with God and to build community.

How is the weekend structured?

The CEW weekend begins on Friday evening at 8:00 PM and ends at about 5:00PM on Sunday. Participants and team members will spend the weekend at the school. All meals are included and sleeping is dormitory style. *(contact your director if you have any special sleeping needs).*

What happens on a CEW?

The weekend is presented by a lay team of parishioners and a priest or deacon. A series of talks, discussions, and activities are offered, as well as time for prayer and personal reflection. This is a time to be open to the Holy Spirit and allow God to meet you through the people present on the weekend.

What does the weekend cost?

The full amount of the cost for the weekend is \$30.00. We ask that you include \$30.00 with the application. Make your check payable to St. Joseph the Worker CEW.

No one is turned away from the weekend because of money!
